The Scottish Government has provided £8 million to the District Heating Loan Fund and funding is also available through the Warm Homes Fund.

Aberdeen City Council and Aberdeen Heat & Power have to date developed 4 Gas CHP District Heating Networks in Aberdeen city. These networks provide affordable heat to over 2500 dwellings and 15 public buildings. Business and Commercial sector can now connect.



Of the cities 59 residential multi-storey blocks, 41 are connected to District or Communal heating, with at least 10 more planned to be connected within the next 3 years.



In the UK there are over 210,000 households on an estimated 2,000 district heating networks.

An estimated 14% of UK heat demand could be cost effectively met by heat networks by 2030 according to the UK government, up from 1-2% today.
